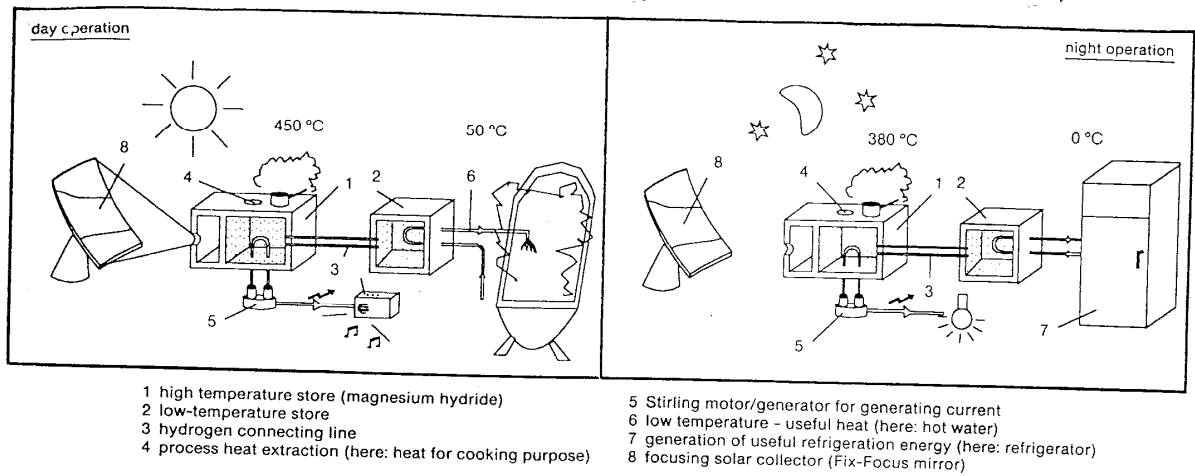


Whoever worships lord Krishna and applies chandan all over lord Krishna goes to vaikuntha. Any **japa**, **homa**, **pitru tarpana**, or **dhana** done that day becomes **a-kshaya** means he **earns lots of good karma** that day. In the Mahabharata, the Pandavas received the **Akshaya Pathram (bowl)** from Lord Krishna on this day. The Akshaya Pathram provided **unlimited food** for the Pandavas during their exile. Due to this reason, people **believe** that anything that is acquired on this day will be replenished. This day is especially important as on this day any thing you **donate** is **akshaya** or **never ending**. Therefore people conduct special puja for **Goddess Lakshmi** and buy new gold and silver ornaments and invest money in shares and real estate. This festival is widely celebrated in all parts of India by different sections of the society irrespective of their religious faith and social grouping.

On Akshaya Tritiya day, the **Sun** and the **Moon** are most radiant and best placed, and hence every moment on this day is considered as auspicious. It falls on the third day (Tritiya) of the bright half moon of the Vaisakha month of Hindu calendar which happens in April-May. In the year (**2008**) this auspicious day come on **7th of May**, as per the Calendar (Mathrubhumi).

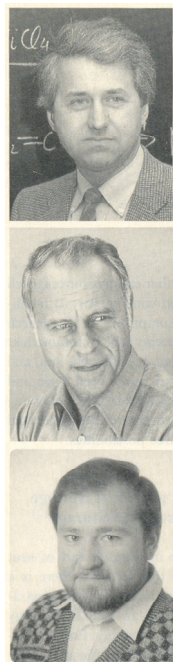
